DAY ONE – 21st NOVEMBER

RELEASE OF THE SPIRIT of PRAYER

And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed. And Simon and they that were with him followed after him. And when they had found him, they said unto him, All men seek for thee. Mark 1:35-37

1. We are all expected to pray. We can't be exempted from it, as the children of God. When we pray, we are humbly requesting that God intervene in earthly affairs. Let us ask the Lord to release upon us, afresh, the Spirit of prayer. Ask the Lord to anoint us anew for prayer and supplication. Ask for the grace to pray like never before.
2. Jesus was found praying while all men were busy seeking after Him. If the Lord could take His prayer life seriously, so much so that He prioritised it above so many other things, we have no excuse not to pray.

Let's ask the Lord to stir up, in us, the passion and the zeal to pray always. Pray for the church, that we will get our priorities right, in the place of prayer. Ask for the church to grow in our prayer lives. Pray that prayer will not be seasonal for us, but that it will be an important part our lives and we will pray in and out of season, in the name of Jesus.

3. We are the light of the world; therefore our lights must shine in our world. It is expected of us, as the ambassadors of Christ to stand in the gap for the world, turn situations around and call things to life with the power of prayer.

Let's ask the Lord for the grace to become fruitful in our prayers. Ask for the church to grow in our prayer lives for relevance in our communities and nations. Ask the Lord for the grace to always surrender to the promptings of the Holy Spirit, to pray.

4. Ask the Lord for the Spirit of wisdom for us to pray intelligently. Ask for the Spirit of humility and obedience for us as individuals and as a church, so that when go before the Lord in prayers, it will be from the place of total surrender to the Holy Spirit's leadings and guidance, not of self.
5. Pray against all spirits of distraction, worries, anxieties and doubts that stand against our prayer lives. Judge everything the devil will try to bring in our way, to take our eyes an focus off praying as we ought. Declare that we have victory over every distraction, laziness, hypocrisy, complacency, discouragement and the likes of them in Jesus name.

DAY TWO – 22nd NOVEMBER

FOR TRUE TRANSFORMATION

Rom 12:2 “And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

1. Pray for spiritual transformation.

True transformation begins with the alignment of our spirit man with the image of Christ. As we are transformed into the image of the glory of Christ through his word, we come to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. The transformation referred to in 2 Cor 3:18 is from glory to glory, from one level to another. Pray that we will experience a next-level transformational move of the Spirit of God.

2. Pray for a fresh release and manifestation of the fruit of the spirit in our lives, as evidence of our spiritual transformation.

The fruit of the Spirit is evidence of spiritual transformation. Let us ask for a fresh manifestation of the fruit of the spirit in our lives, our homes, our places of work and our networks. There is no context in which the fruit of the Spirit is irrelevant and cannot enrich our lives and relationships (“against such there is no law”).

3. Declare that our minds are renewed, and we have the mind of Christ.

Phil 2:5 “Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus”

Let us declare, in the words of that scripture, that we have the mind of Christ. There are two out-workings of the mind of Christ from these two scriptures. First, an unshakeable understanding of our identity in Christ (Phil 2:6) and, second, a deep spiritual revelation of the mind of God (1 Cor 2: 10-15). Declare that these work in us as our minds are renewed in Christ.

4. Declare that we are not just transformed, but are also transforming our world

Light transforms darkness. Our transformation should be a catalyst for change around us, in our families, communities and nations. Let us declare that, because we are transformed, every aspect of our lives will experience transformation. Let us declare that our families will experience transformation. Let us prophecy to every negative situation that has hitherto flourished in the

darkness, and command the light of transformation to shine. We are the light, and no darkness around us can withstand our transformative influence.

5. Declare that the fruit of our mind is transformed
Matt 7:17 "Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit."

When the mind is transformed, then that which proceeds from it must show evidence of that transformation. Declare that, henceforth, the fruit of our mind will be evidence of our transformation. Transformational ideas will proceed from us. The wisdom that proceeds from our minds will transform our lives and our environments. Innovative business ideas and inventions will come from our minds.

6. Pray for the grace to live transformed lives, and walk in our Christ identity, in the name of Jesus.

Pray for the grace to stay focused on Christ, seeing things from an "above" perspective, not just an earthly one. When live from above, and not beneath, then we are truly walking in our Christ identity. Because Christ died for us, we died to sin, resurrected to a new life through him, and are now empowered to live anew as Christ, the anointed one and His anointing. Acknowledging this empowers the communication and walk of our faith and helps us live transformed lives, with our focus on things above and not beneath.

DAY THREE – 23rd NOVEMBER

FOR THE SPIRIT OF WISDOM & REVELATION

There shall come forth a Rod from the ^lb|stem of Jesse, And a Branch shall grow out of his roots. The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.
Isaiah 11:1-2

1. Isaiah declares concerning Jesus that The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him. The Spirit of the Lord is the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, counsel and might, knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. Jesus walked in wisdom all through his life on earth. He knew what to do at all times and in every situation. Because we belong to Christ and as partakers of the divine nature; the same Spirit that was in Christ is in us.

Therefore we have the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, counsel and might, knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. Call forth the manifestation of wisdom in our minds, thought processes and actions. The Spirit of wisdom is at work in us, in Jesus Name.

Support Scriptures: Eph 1:17; Rom 8:11; Philip 2:5; Jn 15:1-2; Gal 2:20; Col 1:27; 1Cor 2:9-10

2. The Spirit of the Lord is also the Spirit of Revelation. He reveals to us things that cannot be seen with the physical eyes, nor perceived in human heart nor heard with physical ears. He reveals to us the deep things of God. God has set out His plans, desires, will and purposes for 2019. These are hidden from the world but can be revealed to us as God's children.

Pray that we will not be in the dark concerning 2019. Pray that God will reveal unto you his purpose for your life in 2019; His mission for you in 2019. Pray that life will not just happen to you in 2019 but through the Spirit of revelation and discernment you will always be one step ahead all the time. You have spiritual intelligence and can discern both the will of God and the plans of the enemy, so you can position yourself appropriately.

Support Scriptures: Col 1:26; Deut 29:29; Rom 11:33; Prov 25:2; Rom 1:16-17

For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness. 1 Corinthians 3:19

3. Sometimes our carnal wisdom (the wisdom of this world) gets in the way of the manifestation of the wisdom of God. At those times, we think that 'we know better' and tend to act out of our natural instinct, understanding, experiences and desires; we do things just like every other earthly human being would. ***Proverbs 14:12 says "There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death."***

Pray that you will not follow the wisdom of this world but will totally rely on the Spirit of wisdom.

Support Scriptures: Rom 12:2, James 3:15-17, Job 5:13, Isa 5:21, 1 Cor 2:6, Prov. 3:5-6

4. Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man. Wisdom is not static, wisdom grows, wisdom increases. Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man. Wisdom increases when as we ask God for more, study His word, learn from men of wisdom, seek counsel.

Pray that God will increase your wisdom and enable you to take the necessary steps to grow in wisdom.

Pray that God will grant you audience with men of influence and wisdom that by your interactions with them you will grow in wisdom.

Support Scriptures: Luke 2:52; Jam 1:5-6, Prov 1:20-23, Ps 1:1-3, 1 Kgs 12:8-16, Prov 13:10

5. Proverbs 1:20-33 declares that Wisdom cries out in the public square, calling out for someone to hear and heed.

Pray that you will not quench the Spirit, but will yield yourself to the Spirit of Wisdom and not resist Him.

Ask that you will receive grace to be obedient to the Spirit of Wisdom for in obedience shall we reap the benefits of Wisdom.

DAY FOUR – 24th NOVEMBER

SALVATION OF SOULS & CHURCH GROWTH

And all that believed were together, and had all things common; And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need. And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

Acts 2:44-47

1. Let's thank God for the souls he has brought into His Kingdom through our prayers and supplications in the London lighthouse.

Thank Him for the power of His word which He constantly sends through the man of God set over the London lighthouse, for equipping us for fruitfulness

2. Let's pray that just as the early church had all things in common, we'll become a people of one vision. Ask the Lord to fill us with the Spirit of love and with the oil of gladness, so that when people observe and see us worship our God, they'll desire to know our God.
3. Pray that our actions and words will not shut people out of the kingdom of God. Let's pray that we'll be true ambassadors of Christ in our words and actions and ultimately find favour with the people in our community and city.
4. The decision of the woman at the well to share what she had experienced caused men to follow her to Jesus. She didn't hide what she discovered, instead, she shared it.
Let's come against every spirit of self which robs people of the blessings of multiplication. Cast down every limiting thoughts contending with the growth of the church of God.
5. Ask the Lord to cause the fire for soul winning to constantly burn in our hearts. Ask that our experience of the move of God and what He is doing our midst in the London Lighthouse will cause for a reawakening in our hearts to respond to the call for soul winning in every area of our influence.

DAY SIX – 26th NOVEMBER

FOR THE WILL AND KINGDOM OF GOD

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Romans 12:2

1. In order to discern the will of God, we need renewed minds. A carnal mind cannot understand the things of the spirit. 1 Corinthians 2:14. Pray that your mind is renewed from this day and through the year 2019 that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Pray that you will take the necessary steps to keep your mind constantly renewed. You will not be conformed to the pattern of this world, you will spend time in prayer, bible study and fellowship with other brethren. Pray that in 2019 we will never be bereft of knowing what the will of God for us is.

Pray that we will know what his will is and in every situation we will hear His voice saying, this is the way walk in it. Isaiah 30:21

2. It is one thing to know what the will of God is, it is another to submit our will to His. Jesus at Gethsemane was faced with either choosing his own will or the will of God. He chose to submit to the will of God.

Pray that our spirit man will be mature enough for us to always submit to God's will. Pray that your will align to His. Pray that whenever there is conflict between your will and His will; His will always wins.

3. When Jesus was teaching his disciples to pray, he said thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Declare and call forth the will of God upon every situation in our life.

Pray that in 2019 your life will be full of heavenly experiences. You will indeed have heaven on earth.

Declare that every situation in your life is brought under the will of God. This includes your health, finances, career, business, family, children etc.

4. One of the things that could hinder the manifestation of the Kingdom of God in our lives is our mindset and thoughts.

Pray that every thought, imagination, ideology that is contrary to the Will and Kingdom of God in your life is cast down. Pray against every internal and

external influences that has the potential to rob us of experiencing the Kingdom of God here on earth.

5. Pray that as you yield to God's will and dwell in His kingdom, you will walk in righteous, experience His peace that transcends all understanding, and always live in the joy of the Holy Ghost. **1 Corinthians 4:20 declares that "the kingdom of God is not in word but in power."** Pray for the demonstration of the power of God that comes through His kingdom. Pray for confidence to stand and walk boldly in the power of God.

1. Thank God for the testimonies and miracles that we have experienced in this ministry in the past months of the year. Praise God for confirming his word in the mouth of his servant Pastor Temi with signs and wonders following.
2. Decree that significant miracles of the salvation of souls continue to be birth in the midst of us. Decree that the word of God preached in the ministry will bring repentance and a change of heart to the un-churched and unsaved in their multitude.
3. Pray for the miracles of healing and deliverance in the midst of us. Decree that House on the Rock London Lighthouse is indeed Mount Zion and so there is holiness and deliverance within her walls. DAY EIGHT – 28th NOVEMBER

FOR OPEN DOORS, FINANCIAL BREAKTHROUGH AND PROSPERITY IN 2019

3 John 1:2 “Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.”

1. Thank God for His provision.

2 Pet 1:3 “As His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue”

Thank the Lord for His blessing of prosperity and favour upon us. His divine power has given us everything we need for life. Thank Him because He is able to exceed our expectations and cause us to prosper beyond our expectations in 2019.

2. Prophecy to the heavens and the earth; command them to work together for your prosperity.

Psalm 107:15-16 “Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He has broken the gates of bronze, and cut the bars of iron in two.”

The gate of bronze in this scripture signifies closed heavens, and the bars of iron an unfruitful earth (see Deut. 28:23). The psalmist is praising God because He has caused the heavens to open up and pour down rain; and caused the earth to be fruitful. We have a better covenant, in that we can ourselves speak to our heavens and earth, and cause them to open to us. Prophecy to your heavens and your earth, and command them to work together for your prosperity for the rest of this year and in 2019. Use the words of Moses in Deut. 32:1 ““Give ear, O heavens, and I will speak; And hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.”

3. Prophecy to the gates of prosperity and command them to open for you.

Ps 24:7 “Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in.”

We carry the glory of God inside us, and when we walk according to His will, we can command gates to open for the King of glory. Exercise your faith and engage in warfare for open doors, financial breakthrough and prosperity in 2019.

4. Pray for divine direction to sow the right seeds, in the right locations and at the right times.

When we sow according to divine direction, we are guaranteed a harvest. Psalm 126 says that we will “doubtless” reap our harvest with rejoicing. Pray for divine direction towards prosperity in 2019. God can, and will if we ask, order our steps to make the right connections, speak to the right people, sow the right seeds, make the right investments, get the right training, and be at the right place at the right time.

5. Pray for increased financial harvest and prosperity.

2 Cor 9:10-11 “Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.”

In Genesis 26:12, Isaac reaped a hundredfold after sowing by divine direction. Let us begin to call forth a hundredfold harvest for every seed we have sown, and will sow by divine direction. Jer 5:24 says that God reserves for His people the appointed weeks of their harvest. That means that even seeds that we have forgotten and harvests we have given up on; God can and does reserve for us. Call forth every lost harvest and declare that in the rest of 2018 and 2019 they will come back to us.

6. Declare that the rest of 2018 will be prosperous.

Psalm 66:11 “You crown the year with Your goodness, And Your paths drip with abundance.”

2018 is not yet over, and there are still enough opportunities for us to prosper. Declare that this year is crowned with God's goodness, and abundance will be our testimony as the year comes to a close. We will walk in the blessing of “more than enough” in this season.

DAY NINE – 29th NOVEMBER

SPIRITUAL WARFARE AGAINST EVERY PLAN OF THE ENEMY

"See I have appointed you today over nations and kingdoms, to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and plant" Jeremiah 1:10.

"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places" Ephesians 6:12.

1. Thank God for his promises and covenant that guarantees the victory for us. Decree that only the counsel of God shall stand concerning the circumstances in our lives.
2. Enforce your victory and:
 - Pronounce that as sons and daughters of the Kingdom who are redeemed and justified, nothing of the enemy shall harm us.
 - Decree that we will not fall prey in to the hands of the enemy, but are preserved and kept safe from the strife of tongue and from the wickedness in the world.
 - Enact the blood of Jesus over our lives, our families, and the church; decree that the blood is our Passover. Declare that when the enemy shall come against us like a flood, the spirit of God will lift up a standard against it.
 - Pronounce victory over insufficiency and lack. Decree that as a people and as a church, the abundance of resources now becomes our new normal. Decree that our hands will always have more than enough to fulfil our mandate in the land and to give for every good work.
 - Pray for divine health and pronounce judgement over sicknesses and diseases. Decree that everyone who is sick in our camp receives their healing speedily. Command that the pestilence and plague in the land shall not come near us, or near our dwelling.
3. Hold bound, systems, strongholds and barriers that have worked against us until now. Pronounce benediction and decree that our warfare and night season is ended.
4. Pray against the spirit of delay. Activate the ministry of angels and command a speedy turn around in all our life's circumstances. Decree that henceforth, all things begin to work together for our good; crooked places are made straight, valleys are exalted and mountains are brought low. Decree that now our mouths are filled with laughter and there are no more tears, because of the fullness of joy that has come.

5. Wage war with the good word of prophecy that we have received for this year and also this month. Decree that we begin to experience the full manifestation of the transformative power of God in its entire ramification.
